For your records, enclosed is an updated Attachment 1 to the Production Accountant Group Designation (Code 59 Non-Affiliate Agreement), the updated Attachment 1 is effective January 4, 2010, and it updates the contribution rate for production accountants employed by Employers in New York or New Jersey, or hired in New York or New Jersey to perform services outside those states, but within the limits of the U.S., its territories and Canada.

**ATTACHMENT I**

CONTRIBUTION RATES IN EFFECT FROM

**AUGUST 2, 2009 THROUGH JULY 31, 2011**

Important Note: Wage scales for Nonaffiliate Accountants are determined by individual negotiation between the employer and the employee. Therefore, contribution amounts for these classifications are pre-set as noted below and are not based upon the employee's wage scales.

- A. The following rates are subject to the terms and conditions of the respective Exhibits A to the Motion Picture Industry Health Plan, the Motion Picture Industry Pension Plan and the Motion Picture Industry Individual Account Plan and apply to
1. Production accountants who are hired in and work in the Los Angeles area (unless sent from the Los Angeles area by the Employer to perform temporary services outside the Los Angeles area):
    - a. Effective August 2, 2009: \$3.9875 per hour
  2. Effective January 1, 2005, production accountants who are employed by Employers who are \$15M Contributors, as that term is defined in the Plans and the Health Plan, and who are employed by such Employers in New York or New Jersey, or hired in New York or New Jersey to perform services outside those states, but within the limits of the U.S., its territories and Canada:
    - a. Effective August 2, 2009: \$3.9875 per hour
  3. Effective January 1, 2005, production accountants who are employed by all other Employers in New York or New Jersey, or hired in New York or New Jersey to perform services outside those states, but within the limits of the U.S., its territories and Canada:
    - a. Effective January 25, 2009: \$10.0870 per hour
    - b. Effective January 24, 2010: \$ 9.7970 per hour

B. In addition to contributions referenced above, IAP percent contributions are due as follows:

1. In the case of **weekly "on-call" Employees** IAP percent contributions are due as follows (note that these are the total amounts of contributions due for each **week**):
